On-site Education Sessions

Lunt Meadows is a haven for rare wetland wildlife, designed to function as a flood storage reservoir in times of extreme weather, it is also home to the remains of 9000 year old Mesolithic stone age settlements.



During the on site school visits, your school will have the use of the Classroom in the Learning Centre, and you will have an enthusiastic and experienced member of the Education team dedicated to your group throughout your visit.

All sessions are fully risk assessed and will suit and compliment the National Curriculum.

Options available for half day and full day sessions.

Full day is generally two workshops, half day is one workshop.

**Full day - starts at £275 for a maximum of 35 children
(after 30 children - £9 per additional child)
Half day - from £180 for up to 35 children**
